


# 2. Do They Use the Latest Technology & Offer All the Available Treatment Options?






# 5. Is the Final Quoted Fee All-Inclusive or Are There Hidden Charges?

Making sure your orthodontist gives you an all-inclusive quoted fee will prevent any costly surprises down the road.





Orthodontics is not just for kids! Orthodontists can help both adults and children achieve a beautiful and healthy smile.


